Volunteer Registration and Rules

- 1. All volunteers must be registered by **July 20**.

- 4. Volunteers must attend at least one **Volunteer Orientation** organised before the Africa Pavilion is in session.
- 5. Volunteers offering 10 hours or more of service are entitled to a Certificate of Appreciation from ACOMI. Please indicate this on the application form.
- 6. The Africa Pavilion will NOT accept 'Walk-In' volunteers. 'Walk-In' volunteers are people who turn up at the Africa Pavilion during the event to offer volunteer services.
- 7. Volunteers will receive Africa Pavilion identification from the Volunteer Coordinator.
- 8. Volunteers must have their "Africa Pavilion" identification with them at all times during the event or they may be ejected from the Pavilion or asked to purchase a ticket to watch the show.
- 9. Volunteers must always sign-in and sign-out at the Volunteer Desk.
- 10. Volunteers must take direction from and address their grievances through the Volunteer Coordinator
- 11. Volunteers must adhere to the Africa Pavilion dress-code and personal hygiene regulations
- 12. Volunteers are not allowed to take guests' seats when the show is in progress
- 13. Volunteers are not allowed to stand around the Pavilion entrances or against the walls in the hall, entrances or stairways
- 14. Volunteers who do not adhere to the given rules and instructions will be ejected or made to leave the premises or they may purchase tickets to watch the show.
